The McGill University Faculties of Medicine, Dentistry and Science are inviting applications for full-time tenure track positions at the level of Assistant Professor or Associate Professor. There are five such positions available over the next 1-3 years. These positions are linked to the Canada Excellence Research Chair in Human Pain Genetics. The candidates will join a team of researchers in the Alan Edwards Centre for Research on Pain. The initial appointment is for three years, and this is renewable.

Successful applicants must have a PhD or equivalent degree, and/or an MD (or other health professional degree), and at least three years of postdoctoral research training in one of the following fields: statistical genetics, human clinical genetics, molecular biology/pharmacology, electrophysiology, immunology, animal pain models, psychology, brain and cellular imaging and/or clinical research.
